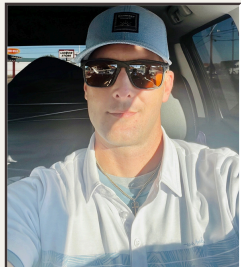

## Resident Spotlight



When James came to Another Chance House in September 2024, he says he was broken and felt hopeless. Years of addiction had taken a toll on his life, his marriage, and his sense of direction. But even at his lowest, he wasn't alone. His two daughters believed in him. James says that was all he needed, along with God, to start stacking days and doing the next right thing.

James openly shares that he survived four accidental overdoses between 2017 and 2023. **"I should be dead,"** he says. But he chose to fight for a different future.

From the beginning, James put his head down and fully invested in the program. When he faced a setback early on, he did not make excuses. He humbled himself, reset his sobriety date, and decided he was "going all in." That moment became a turning point.

Today, James continues to live at Another Chance House while rebuilding his life with purpose. Recently, he was promoted to General Manager at his job, a milestone he once could not imagine reaching. He approaches each day with gratitude, remembering where he came from and what truly matters.

**"God, family, and being the best father I can be."**

James is living proof that even when someone feels beyond hope, change is possible. **And he is not done yet.**
